The Center of Excellence for Technology Education

The Center of Excellence for Technology Education-Network (CETE-Network) is a research association, consisting of leading, academic research institutions within the sector of technology and engineering education. Supporting the qualification of new blood for technical jobs by encouraging engineering education is the aim of the international network CETE.

The network, being fostered by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) is directed by Prof. Dr. Ingelore Mammes, holder of the chair for School Research at the University of Duisburg-Essen. Academic partners within the network are the University of Luxembourg, the Delft University of Technology, the University of Applied Sciences and Arts North-western Switzerland, the University of Missouri and the University of Cambridge.

The CETE network offers a large variety of informational and educational events. In addition to regular meetings of CETE members, workshops and summer schools are offered for young scientists, students, apprentices and teaching staff. Anyone who is interested in topics such as digital media, early engineering education in primary schools, engineering education in secondary schools and in vocational schools or STEM education, is welcome to join.

The **CETE Summer School 2018** will be offered to all doctoral and master students. Eight students from each CETE partner country are funded by DAAD and get a lump sum for accommodation expenses and travelling expenses for three days:
